

CPD1102 Professional Development and Ethics

Unit description

CPD1102 Professional Development and Ethics places major emphasis on understanding the processes of continuing professional development and competency acquisition to take advantage of career opportunities when they arise. In addition, the unit will establish and strengthen academic rigor. Students gain the ability to retrieve, interpret and summarise academic journal articles and produce an annotated bibliography, literature review, and proposal for future research. The importance of tertiary academic skills including planning, organisation, and integration of academic language, paraphrasing, summarising, and application of referencing conventions, are strongly emphasised to effectively prepare students for written assessments at tertiary level. This unit is a core unit in the GradCertPM, GradDipPM and MBPM programs.

- [ULO2] Define and refine one's own professional goals and set career development targets.
