Unit description

BUS6004 Enterprise Information Systems introduces students to the uses of information systems in generating business value for organisations. It deals with a range of enterprise information requirements, the application of information systems to business problems and recent developments and technologies in the marketplace. The unit emphasises organisational strategies for information systems and design activities including working in design teams. Students will learn how to plan, acquire and implement enterprise systems to optimally meet business needs and requirements. The unit also considers the key aspect of risk and security in managing large-scale businesses and particularly computing organisations.
