

BUS3014 Procurement and Risk Management

Unit Description

This unit provides conceptual and practical knowledge, skills, and frameworks to manage a project's risks, quality, and resource procurement. Through the unit's learning and assessment activities, students will develop a quality management plan for a project; develop a project risk management plan (including risk response implementation and risk monitoring strategies); and develop a project procurement plan using a relevant procurement methodology.
