

## **Credit Transfer Agreement between ECA College** and

## **Asia Pacific International College** Valid from 28/07/2021 until 28/07/2023

Credit Transfer Agreement (Agreement) concerning students entering the APIC Master of Project Management and Business (MPMB) or the APIC Master of Business Administration (MBA) from the following ECA College courses:

**BSB80120** Graduate Diploma of Management (Learning) MEM80112 Graduate Diploma of Engineering

APIC undertakes to award block credit transfer to graduates of the program specified in Appendix A who have successfully completed the specified units.

For the above ECA College courses and their units listed in Appendix A, APIC grants the following Credits.

- A maximum of 6 (six) credits can be granted for the BSB80120 Graduate Diploma of Management (Learning) into the Master of Project Management and Business. That is 2 (two) specified credits and 4 (four) unspecified credits.
- A Maximum of 5 (five) credits can be granted for the MEM80112 Graduate Diploma of Engineering into the MPMB. That is 1 (one) specified credits and 4 (four) unspecified credits.
- A Maximum of 6 (six) credits can be granted for the BSB80120 Graduate Diploma of Management (Learning) into the Master of Business Administration. That is 2 (two) specified credits and 4 (four) unspecified credits.

The following Table 1, identifies the specified credit which can be granted when completing a specific unit within the two ECA College courses listed in Appendix A.

Specified credits are only granted for core units. An unspecified credit may be granted for any unit not listed in Table 1.

The maximum number of unspecified credits is four.

- 1. Credit cannot be granted for courses or units completed more than five years before the date of commencing the APIC award course.
- 2. APIC reserves the right to specify the course components required for course completion regarding both course content and core graduate attributes. APIC also reserves the right to amend, alter, update, or discontinue any aspect of the course components upon giving reasonable notice to ECA College.
- 3. This Agreement will apply from 28/07/2021 until 28/07/2023 unless it is otherwise updated or replaced with a new Agreement. Either party may terminate this Agreement during the term upon providing written notice of six months to the other party. If the Agreement is terminated by either party, students who have commenced their study at APIC before notification of termination of this Agreement will be permitted to complete the award in which they are enrolled.
- 4. This Agreement is subject to students completing the units specified in the tables in Appendix A.
- 5. If there are significant changes to either course or the status of ECA College, then the college initiating the change (ECA College or APIC) will undertake to commence a review of this Agreement.
