



## Credit Transfer Agreement between ECA College and Asia Pacific International College

**Valid from 1 January 2026 to 31 December 2027**

On successful completion of the **Graduate Diploma of Engineering** or **Graduate Diploma of Management (Learning)** at **ECA College**, a student is eligible for entry into **Master of Project Management and Business** at **Asia Pacific International College (APIC)** with credit worth 48 credit points transferred towards their degree.

3. Credit cannot be granted for courses or units completed more than ten (10) years before the commencement date of the APIC course.

4. APIC reserves the right to specify course components, including course content and core graduate attributes, required for course completion. Any substantial modifications will be communicated to ECA College with reasonable notice, ensuring minimal disruption to enrolled students.
5. This Agreement shall remain in effect from 01/01/2026 until 31/12/2027. Either party may terminate the Agreement by providing six (6) months written notice to the other party. Students who have commenced their studies at APIC prior to the termination notice will be guaranteed the right to complete their enrolled award under the existing terms.
6. In the event of significant changes to course structure, institutional status, or accreditation of either ECA College or APIC, the initiating party shall:
  - a) Provide immediate written notification to the other party
  - b) Commence a comprehensive review of this Agreement within thirty (30) days of the change
  - c) Propose amendments to ensure continued alignment of educational objectives
7. ECA College may display the APIC logo and information pertaining to this Agreement on its web page and in official marketing material during the period of the Agreement following notification to and approval from APIC.
